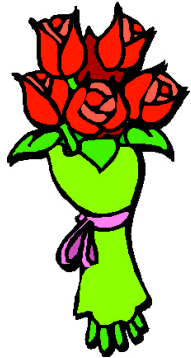


CCBC Purpose Statement
