While the elementary age kids go to their stations, the Preschoolers go to their room and share in activities appropriate to their age.

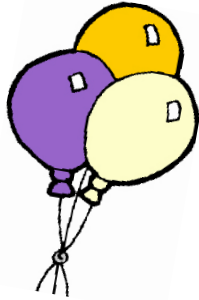
We gather together at the close for a special snack, often prepared by one of the groups and God sightings, a final song and prayer.

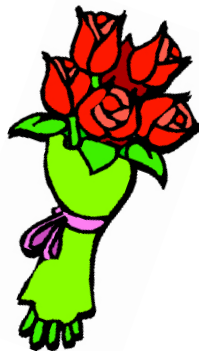
